- **3.3 School Board Election Information** The 2016-2017 school year is an election year for school board members. At the October school board meeting, Kassy Miller shared the information she had received regarding the election. Candidate packets are available in the Clinton County Clerk's office and on Clinton County's website. The first day to circulate petitions was September 20; the first day to file nomination papers is December 12; the last day to file nomination papers is December 19; a minimum of 33 petition signatures by registered voters is required.
- **3.4 North Wamac Grade School HLS Renovations Update** The HLS renovations are nearing completion. C & K Heating and Cooling has completed the projects in the office and gymnasium. The only remaining project is the front awning to be installed by Shores Builders. Lunsford Architects will be in contact with Shores Builders to determine how soon they will be able to complete this project.

- **4.1 FY18 Tax Levy** Mr. Morris has prepared a tentative copy of the proposed tax levy for the FY18. He believes North Wamac should maintain the standard 4.99% tax levy. As with the past several levies, he is proposing that we should continue to recoup our levy in the IMRF as we had done last year. Additionally, we had already decreased the levy in the tort fund last year by \$10,000 due to the strong reserves held in this fund. Therefore, he is proposing that the school continues to recoup just the standard 4.99% for FY18. Board members will need to vote on adopting the levy at the December school board meeting.
- **4.2 Basketball Team/Cheerleading Update** North Wamac's basketball season is in full swing. We have had several varsity and junior varsity games at this juncture, as well as several 5th grade games. Our teams' records currently stand at 2-3 (5th grade team), 5-1 (junior varsity team), and 4-7 (varsity team).
- **4.3 Eighth Grade Grandparent/District Senior Citizen Christmas Luncheon** The Eighth Grade Grandparent/District Senior Citizen Christmas Luncheon will be held at 12:00 p.m. on Friday, December 16, 2016, in the Vic Dorris Gymnasium.
