2021-2022 Back to School Plan

- The school will return to full 5 days in-person learning.
- School will be in session daily from 8:00-3:00p.m.
- **Due to the recent mandate by Governor J.D. Pritzker, all faculty, staff and students will be required to wear masks throughout the duration of the school day until further notice.**
- The district will be prepared to adjust educational and athletic programming as necessary throughout the year.
- All passengers and drivers must wear a mask on school buses.
- A driver does not need to wear a mask if he/she is the only person on the bus.
- ANY student who is on remote must have a medical doctor's excuse. Remote learning will only be temporarily available if a student is under quarantine and not eligible for a vaccine.
- Temperature checks and symptom screenings will be discontinued. Parents should keep their children home from school if they are sick or exhibiting symptoms.
- Good hand hygiene will be strongly encouraged at all grade levels.
- Social distancing will be maintained in all school areas to the greatest extent feasible.
- Buildings will continue to undergo increased cleaning/sanitation.
- Student meals will be free for the 2021-2022 school year in accordance with USDA reimbursements.
- Students will be issued individual devices (Chromebooks).
- Athletic programs will run as normal with full activity fees charged and admission charged at indoor, home sporting events.
- Field trips and fundraisers will resume as normal.
